**Fast forward to 2012. Puerto Armuelles is in full recovery mode.**

- Its road to the InterAmericana is growing from 2 to 4 lanes.
- A large port facility is scheduled for construction.
- The 2 projects above will create a 4 lane “dry canal” from the Pacific to the Caribbean. This “dry canal “ is expected to have a similar economic effect on Puerto Armuelles as the “wet canal” has always had on Panama City.
- It is an official duty free zone for business and industry. **Which means it has a zero tax base for businesses!**
